The event was originally set to take place in February at the Wisconsin Center but was postponed due to the COVID-19 pandemic. For this year, the auto show will take place at the Wisconsin State Fair Park, 640 S. 84<sup>th</sup> Street West Allis, WI 53214, allowing for spacious indoor exhibit space as well as several outdoor displays and activities. Contactless ticket scanners will be in place at the show entrance. Admission for online advance tickets is \$10 for adults (13 and over). Special opening day tickets \$6 online at <u>autoshowmilwaukee.com</u>. Tickets purchased online during the show will be \$11 for adults. Tickets are also available on site for \$12. Senior citizens (62 and older) are \$9 (available Wednesday to Friday). Children (6-12) are \$6. Sunday is Family Day, children 12 and under are admitted free when accompanied by an adult. Ample parking is available for \$6.
