

Greater Milwaukee Car & Truck Show Returns To Wisconsin Center February 26-March 6 New Model Vehicles, Luxury Vehicles, Classic Cars and More

MILWAUKEE, Wis. (February 10, 2022) -- Featuring hundreds of new vehicles, pre-production models, luxury vehicles and more, the 2022 <u>Greater Milwaukee International Car & Truck Show</u> will return to the Wisconsin Center, Friday, February 26, to Sunday, March 6, 2022. Admission to the event is \$12 for adults when purchased online. Seniors (62 and older) are \$10; children (8-12) are \$6; and children 7 and under are FREE.
